Lichfield Society of Artists Exhibition June 27th, 28th and 29th.

Preparation for this Summer's exhibition.

By now you should be thinking seriously about what you intend to enter in this year's Exhibition in June.

It will be a three-day event, Friday 27th, Saturday 28th, and Sunday 29th, and held, as usual at the Guildhall in Lichfield. I will be putting the entry form out the first week in June, and likewise the on-line entry form. You will have two weeks in which to enter, and this will end a week before the exhibition which will give us a window to process all entries.

Please note, anything received in this period will not be accepted. Insurance is your responsibility; we are covered for public liability only.

You must be a fully paid-up member for this year to enter.

1. You must be able to bring your work in at the correct time on the Friday morning, or someone else can bring it in for you.

2. When you send your form in you must pay the correct fee at the same time, either by cheque, or bank transfer (details on the entry form).

3. You must be able to do stewarding duty at least once (a two-hour period), or someone else can do it for you.

4. Collection of unsold work at 4pm on the last day, no earlier. We leave promptly from the Guildhall, so do NOT be late. Please **DO NOT** arrive and remove work before 4pm.

All details will be on the entry forms, but Ts and Cs will explain further.

So, you have a fortnight to get your entries ready, labelled correctly and packaged. Make sure they are tidy, and the framing is in a professional condition. Your work should look as you would wish to buy it yourself. "D" rings and string for hanging and two labels, one on string to hang forward, and one affixed to the back.

Cards for the shop area need to be cellophaned, priced and labelled. Maximum 20, e.g., BW1 to BW20, and must come with an accompanied list which we call a proforma.

Other items can be sold in the shop, i.e. fabrics, jewellery.

FUSE Festival 2025
